- VHF/UHF radio -TYT-8600 on Dual band Comet Antenna at approx. 50 ft.

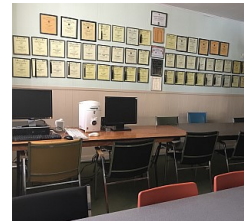

- >25Mb upload & download synchronous network connection to the VA4WAN network



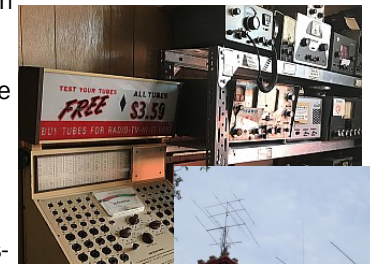
